TO: Customs Brokers, Importers and Others Concerned

SUBJECT: Required use of Bonded Transportation

A request for the movement of cargo to a U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) bonded warehouse or exam facility requires the use of CBP bonded transportation. When a CBP bonded warehouse is providing the movement, their bond may be used to provide the transfer of cargo. If a third party is providing the transfer of bonded cargo, that party must be bonded.

All parties that send requests for Permits to Transfer to the Amschicago@cbp.dhs.gov email address are required to provide the IR number of the third party trucking company being used or confirm that the bonded facility is providing the cargo movement. When notifying CBP of the chosen central examination station (CES) facility for a local transfer, please also include the IR number of the third party trucking company or confirm that the CES facility is providing the movement.
