SUBJECT: Extension of Port Limits of Rockford, Illinois

In the Federal Register dated January 17, 2006, the final rule was published extending the geographical limits of the Port of Rockford, Illinois.

Effective February 16, 2006, the geographical limits of the Port of Rockford will include the City of Rochelle, Illinois. This extension accommodates the Union Pacific Railroad Company's inter-modal facility in Rochelle, Illinois.

The new limits of the port will read as follows:

"Bounded to the north by the Illinois/Wisconsin border; bounded to the west by Illinois State Route 26; bounded to the south by Interstate Route 88; bounded to the east by Illinois State Route 23 to the Wisconsin/Illinois border."
