Subject: New Email Addresses for CBP Agriculture Ocean and Air Cargo.

The Port of Chicago established an electronic mail box for agriculture air cargo and agriculture inland (ocean) cargo, as a result of brokers and forwarders expressing an interest in communicating electronically with these departments. The email address can be used for sending routine documents such as ingredient lists, copies of permits, and container manifests. Certain original documents such as phytosanitary certificates and veterinary certificates must still be presented in paper form.
